We are pleased to announce that Delhi Public School, Surajkund, is implementing the Holistic Progress Card (HPC) for students in Montessori to Class I, in line with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. This new system aims to provide a comprehensive and balanced assessment that recognizes each child's unique strengths, talents, and growth across all areas of development.

Aligned with NEP 2020, the HPC offers a 360-degree perspective on student development, encompassing cognitive, emotional, social, and physical growth. The progress card includes competencies directly linked to curriculum goals, presenting a thorough view of each child's development across multiple dimensions. These competencies reflect essential skills and attributes that extend beyond academic achievement, highlighting our holistic educational approach.

The Curricular Goals for the Foundational Stage are designed considering the following domains:

- **Pranamaya & Annamaya Kosha (Physical Development):** Curriculum Goals 1 to 3
- **Manomaya Kosha (Socio-emotional and Ethical Development):** Curriculum Goals 4 to 6
- **Vijnanamaya Kosha (Cognitive Development):** Curriculum Goals 7 to 8
- **Language and Literacy Development:** Curriculum Goals 9 and 10 (Language - 1) and 11 (Language - 2)
- **Anandamaya Kosha (Aesthetic and Cultural Development):** Curriculum Goal 12
- **Positive Learning Habits:** Curriculum Goal 13

The HPC is designed to promote a collaborative approach to student development, incorporating self-assessment, peer assessment, parent feedback, and teacher evaluation. It also includes progress in projects, quizzes, group work, role play, and more.

Self-Assessment

This encourages children to become self-aware and take responsibility for their own learning, helping them understand their progress in various learning activities.

Peer Assessment

This offers insight into a child's engagement level in both individual and group activities while learning to give constructive feedback to peer group.

Parent Feedback

This strengthens the connection between home and school by involving parents in their child's learning and development. It is the feedback that is taken from the parent based on their child's strengths and areas for improvement over a period, in different learning activities.
