This ensures that all issues are recorded, tracked, and resolved in a timely and systematic manner. We encourage you to avoid using informal or unofficial channels, as they may lead to delays or miscommunication. Your cooperation will help us respond more efficiently and maintain transparency in all communications.
- Parents are further requested to **communicate with teachers only during the designated time slots** shared by them and be courteous in their interactions. We also urge you to respect their privacy, personal time as well as their mental well-being. Constructive and considerate communication helps build a positive learning environment for all.
- We would also like to inform you that a school app will soon be introduced to streamline all forms of communication. Once implemented, parents are requested to strictly adhere to this platform for all interactions, ensuring clarity, consistency, and effective coordination.

- Parents are informed that a **“Know Your Concepts”** bridge course was conducted from April 01-April 15, 2026 to strengthen foundational understanding and help students smoothly transition into the new curriculum. We will now be starting with this year’s curriculum.
