Date of the Competition: January 27, 2025

Students are encouraged to practice all the 'Word Bank' words that are being taught and revised in school. The same list has been pasted in their English notebook for regular practice at home.

Competition Rounds & Execution

To ensure a fair and exciting competition, the Spell Bee will be conducted in the following rounds:

Round 1 – Written Round- January 19, 2025

Students will be given a set of words to write. Selected participants from this round will qualify for Round 2.

Round 2 – Oral Spelling Round- January 22, 2025

Selected students will spell words orally in front of an audience. Participants who spell the maximum number of words correctly will move to the Final Round.

Round 3 – Rapid-Fire Finale- January 27, 2025

Finalists will be given words one after another in rapid succession. The student with the highest accurate score will be declared the winner.

- Time Taken to Spell
