We look forward to partnering with you in this enriching journey of joyful learning and meaningful connections.





In the coming month, children will engage in a variety of interactive language and communication activities.

General Conversation:


We will continue to practice everyday greetings and polite expressions like "How are you?", "I am fine, thank you," and "Nice to meet you," through role-play and circle time. Identity-based conversations,, such as "I am a boy/girl" will also be reinforced. The children will be introduced to the name of their school.

Picture Description:

Children will explore picture comprehension using everyday scenes and festival themes. Activities will encourage observation, vocabulary building, and storytelling through guided questions, flashcards, big books, and real-life photos.

Words used in Everyday Life:

We will introduce action words like walk, run, jump, and clap through songs, games, Born to Move sessions, and dramatization. Physical movement and role-play will help children understand and express meaningfully. Simple opposites such as dry/wet, open/close, and stand/sit will be introduced through flashcards, real-life examples, and fun sorting games.
