STEM for Young Learners: Engaging Activities*

- 1. Science: Create a balance scale using a plastic hanger, cups, and strings, allowing children to experiment with weight and measurement.
- 2. Technology: Introduce basic tools like magnifying glasses, measuring spoons, and toy cameras, enabling preschoolers to explore their surroundings through hands-on interaction.
- 3. Engineering:Foster problem-solving skills through activities like building, designing, and testing structures with blocks, boxes, and other materials.
- 4. Mathematics:Practice counting and basic numeracy skills using everyday objects, such as toys, snacks, or steps, making math accessible and fun.
