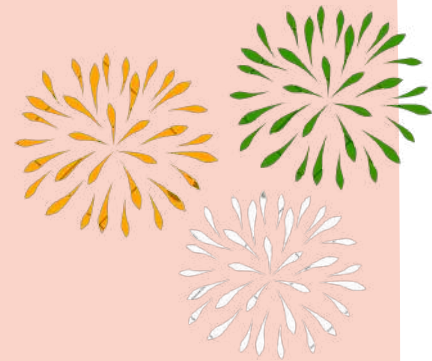

At DPSSK, our curriculum is designed to deliver experiential learning through STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics) activities aligned with the National Curriculum Framework 2022. As we move forward, we continue to prioritize the development of skills across various domains specified in the Framework through integrated STEAM activities.

STEAM

STEAM-Based Activities for The Month: - Fizzing Ice Cubes – Colours That Melt & Mix!

- ◆ **Science:** Explore what happens when baking soda and vinegar mix – observe fizzing and melting!
- ◆ **Art & Creativity:** Watch and describe the colour blending as ice melts and fizzes.
- ◆ **Observation & Inquiry:** Predict what happens when vinegar touches the ice; compare results using different colours.
- ◆ **Math Skills:** Count fizzing cubes, track and compare which melts faster.
- ◆ **Engineering & Problem-Solving:** Try changing the size of ice trays to see if size of the ice cube affects melting time .
- ◆ **Language Development:** Use words like “fizz,” “melt,” “cold,” “bubble,” “mix,” and “change.”





Mixing Colours – Different but Together!

- ◆ **Science:** Children will observe how different colours mix and create new ones.
- ◆ **Art & Creativity:** They will use brushes, or fingers to freely mix colours, encouraging artistic expression.
- ◆ **Observation & Inquiry:** Children will be encouraged to predict outcomes (e.g., what happens when red and yellow are mixed) and discuss their findings.
- ◆ **Math Skills:** They will count the colours used, track how many new colours they've created, and compare shades.
- ◆ **Engineering & Problem-Solving:** Children will explore different materials (paper, cotton, water) to determine which surface helps colours mix best.
- ◆ **Language Development:** Vocabulary focus includes “mix,” “together,” “new,” “same,” “different,” “beautiful,” encouraging descriptive language and communication.
