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STEAM

At DPSSK, our curriculum is designed to deliver experiential learning through STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics) activities aligned with the National Curriculum Framework 2022. As we move forward, we continue to prioritize the development of skills across various domains specified in the Framework through integrated STEAM activities.

STEAM Based Activities for the Month:

- Animal Shadow Art will allow students to observe and trace shadows of animal cut-outs using flashlights. This encourages creativity and a basic understanding of light and shadows, combining science with artistic expression.
- Animal Sounds with Cups will demonstrate how sound travels through a simple cup-and-string telephone. Students will decorate their cups with animal stickers, produce corresponding sounds, and exchange them with peers, blending engineering with play.
- Animal-Themed Sensory Bins will provide a tactile exploration of animal habitats. Each bin will recreate ecosystems like jungles or oceans with toy animals, sand, water, and leaves. This activity enhances sensory development and builds an understanding of diverse habitats.
