Language and Literacy – Engaging transport stories, action rhymes, and vocabulary building related to vehicles and travel.

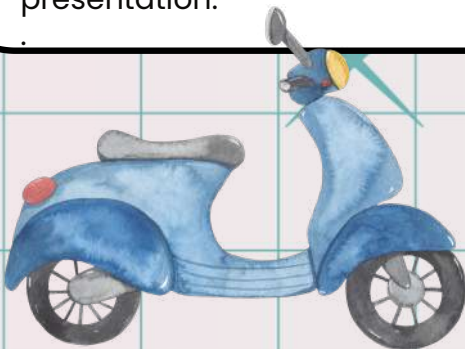
Cognitive Development – Curiosity-driven inquiry, problem-solving, and learning about different modes of transport and how they help us move from one place to another.

CELEBRATIONS: MARK YOUR CALENDAR

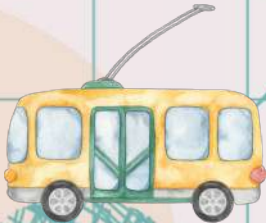

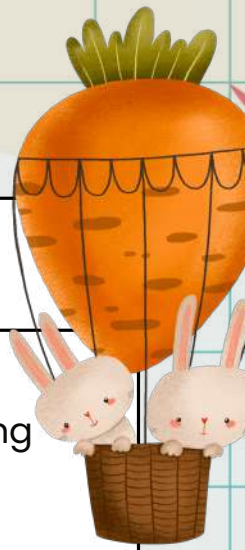
"Engaging Activities for the Month: Themed Learning Adventures"

STEAM



This month's STEAM curriculum is thoughtfully integrated with the ongoing theme, enabling students to deepen their understanding through science, technology, engineering, arts, and mathematics in a meaningful and engaging way.

STEAM Based Activities for the Month:

- Paper Airplane: Students design and fold paper airplanes, testing them to see how far they fly. This activity enhances hand-eye coordination and encourages creative thinking by experimenting with different designs and different speed to improve flight distance and stability.
- Wind-Powered Sailboats: Students create simple sailboats using paper or foam and then blow on them with straws to see how wind is important for a boat to sail. It also improves breath control and patience as children figure out how to make their boats move faster or slower
